Benefits to Healing

In vivo studies have shown that the properties of amniotic membrane help to reduce scar tissue formation and scar attachments to injured/repaired nerves. 1,2 For use as an in vivo nerve wrap in peripheral nerve trauma, AmnioFix provides an effective barrier and contributes to the three phases of the natural healing process:

• Inflammatory Phase

Reduces inflammation at the wound site

Proliferation Phase

Provides a protective barrier; contains a combination of growth factors unique to placental tissue; contains collagen types IV, V, and VII.

• Remodeling Phase

Helps reduce scar tissue formation

The proprietary Purion® Process protects the delicate scaffold during processing, leaving an intact collagen matrix. The result is a durable graft with natural barrier properties that offers surgeons a clear advantage.

- Terminal sterilization using E-Beam, which does not harm AmnioFix or the matrix structure
- AmnioFix is never treated with glutaraldehyde, reducing concerns about potential cytotoxicity

- Dry tissue preservation for simple application
- Unique graft embossment for proper orientation
